

TAL A1 Italian L2 - Listening and Reading

The test lasts **45 minutes** and includes 3 pages of **listening** tasks and 3 pages of **reading** tasks. In order to pass the test, at least 60% of the questions must be answered correctly. Points will not be taken away for incorrect answers.

In order to familiarize with the type, level and format of the test questions, a mock test is available on Moodle, and can be accessed through the section of the Language Centre's website dedicated to the Language Tests "[Preparation for the TAL Tests](#)".

LISTENING:

Task 1:

Candidates listen to three short dialogues in contexts related to university student life. For each dialogue, they select the correct response from three options given.

Task 2:

Candidates listen to five short monologues about aspects of a university student's everyday life. For each monologue, they select the matching question from those given.

Task 3:

Candidates watch a short informative video set in a university context. They then decide whether five statements are True or False based on the information in the video.

READING:

Task 1:

Candidates read three short texts (e-mails or text messages) on formal and informal topics related to university student life. For each text, they select the correct response from three options.

Task 2:

Candidates read five short announcements for university events. For each announcement, they select the matching statement from those given.

Task 3:

Candidates read an informative text set in a university context. They then decide whether five statements are True or False based on the information in the text.
